Membership Enhancement Basket Program

The MEC team will sponsor a Basket Fundraiser at the 2024 Alumni Reunion. All CHS graduating classes may participate by assembling a basket. The invitation is extended to Groups, Families, and Individuals to create a basket. Baskets will be judged, and winners announced during the 2024 Banquet. The basket fundraiser program is voluntary, so a class may choose not to participate.

Rules:

- 1. Participating classes should appoint a representative / designated person that will be responsible for gathering items for their basket.
- 2. Smaller classes may choose to combine resources and create a single basket.
- 3. Baskets may contain any number of items. Such as: gift items, money, gift cards, lottery tickets, soap items, fruit, nuts, cheese, crackers, coffee/tea, towels, wine, sports paraphernalia, games, etc. or a theme basket.
- 4. The designated class representative will collect items and assemble their basket. The completed basket should be given to a local MEC team member on or before May 24, 2024, or brought to the Friday night Meet and Greet event. Each basket must be wrapped with cellophane or other clear wrapping and labeled with the class year or group/family name.
- 5. Baskets will be displayed, and raffle tickets sold during the Friday night Meet and Greet and at the Saturday evening Banquet during the "mingle event" between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM.
- 6. Raffle tickets will be \$1 each, 8 for \$5, 20 for \$10, or 50 for \$20.
- 7. MEC will be responsible for transporting baskets to the banquet.
- 8. Baskets will be raffled off toward the end of Saturday night dinner.
- 9. Must be present to win.
- 10. The proceeds will be used to offset Meet and Greet expenses. Any surplus proceeds will go into CHSAA general funds designated for other CHSAA events / activities.
- 11. There will be incentives recognition for basket categories. 1) Most Creative, Most Unique, Most money raised. Winners will receive a certificate and group pictures taken to be posted on the website. The MEC team believes this Basket Fundraiser Program will be fun, engaging, and an opportunity for classes to be creative, and maybe even spur some competition. A Team Building Opportunity.
