BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

POLICY AND PROCEDURES GUIDE FOR THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND A MEMBER'S POLICY AND PROCEDURES MANUAL

During the April 17, 2023, special meeting the Board approved a policy and procedures manual for all alumni association members and a policy guide for the Executive Board. These two documents provide standards that guide how we interact as leaders and members of CHSAA, Inc. They are intended to provide guidance and direction on how we work with each other and manage the business of the Association. The policies contained in the manuals are in keeping with, and consistent with, the core values of the Association as well as the Constitution and By-laws. The policies and procedures provide a road map for day-to-day operations and ensure compliance with laws and regulations. They also enforce CHSAA, Inc.'s commitment to achieving organizational excellence and transparency of operations.

More specifically, the members' Policy Manual covers anti-discrimination and harassment, code of ethics, communication, health and safety, historical archives, and whistleblower. The Executive Board policies cover conflict of interest, document retention and destruction, finance and budget, gift acceptance, good governance and training and development. Both documents will be available on our website.

FIRST EVER ANNUAL CHSAA, Inc. BUDGET APPROVED

The first ever CHSAA, Inc. annual budget was developed by the Budget Finance/Ways and Means committee. The proposed budget of \$30,884 for the upcoming fiscal year was unanimously approved at the June 26, 2023, Executive Board meeting. The

approved budget is a guiding document that will be used by the board in the exercise of its fiduciary duties to provide oversight over all CHSAA, Inc. financial resources.

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS AMENDMENTS

During quarterly Board meetings over the last fiscal year, 20 amendments were approved. The amendments made administrative, committee or membership clarifications, board financial issues and the addition of policy and procedures manual maintenance responsibility.




